6. CONTROLLING THE CAMERA

Touch Screen Control

The integrated touch display lets you control your camera and its settings, all with a simple tap or swipe. Use these gestures to easily navigate the interface:



1. Live View

- Swipe ↓ : Menu
- Swipe ↑ : Gallery
- Swipe ← : Switch between Video/Camera Mode
- Tap & Hold (finger icon) : Zoom slider (Camera Mode only)

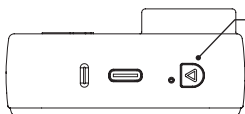
2. Menu and Gallery

- Swipe ← / → : Browse settings, view recorded videos
- Tap (finger icon) : Select an item, toggle a setting on/off, or adjust your preferences

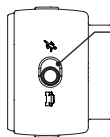
Touch Control Tips:

- Remove the pre-applied protective film to prevent unintentional inputs or delayed responses.
- Keep the screen clean and dry to ensure accurate touch performance.

Button Control

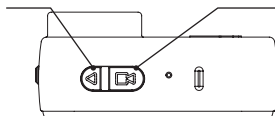


- Menu / Previous / Rewind / Return (click once)



- Body Camera Mode (toggle up)
- Dash Camera Mode (toggle down)

- Lock Video / Next / Fast Forward / Monitor ON/OFF (click once)

Voice Control

The camera's voice control gives you hands-free access to essential functions, whether you're in your car or outdoors. Simply say the command, and let the camera do it for you.

For example, just say:



1. Set the camera to video mode to use voice control.
2. Say **"OK, MINI"**. The camera beeps and starts listening for a command.
3. Say a command.

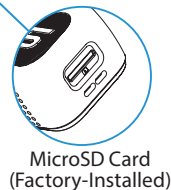
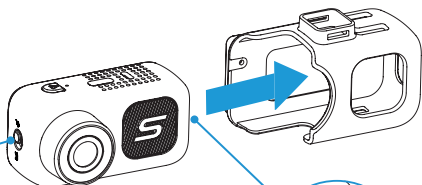
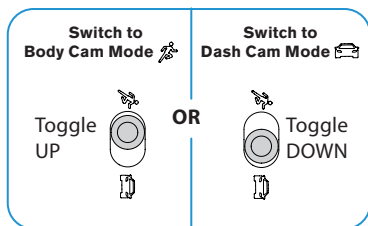

Voice Tips:

- Speak clearly and directly to the camera from a short distance.
- Reduce background noise for better voice recognition.
- Keep the camera lens and microphone clean and unobstructed.

7. INSTALLING THE CAMERA

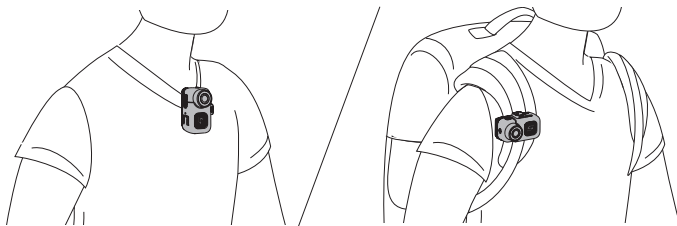
- 1 Insert the camera into the back clip bracket and push it all the way in until you hear a “click”.



Clip Mount (Body Cam Mode):

- 2 Clip the camera onto your clothing, bag, or any suitable object. Make sure it is secure and won't easily detach during use.

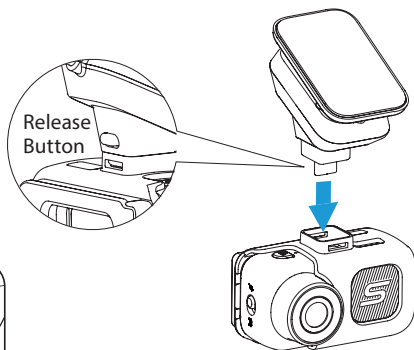
NOTE: The camera is not designed for use in wet conditions, such as rain or snow.



Windshield Mount (Dash Cam Mode):

- 2 Attach the windshield mount to the camera.

NOTE: To detach, press the release button on the mount.

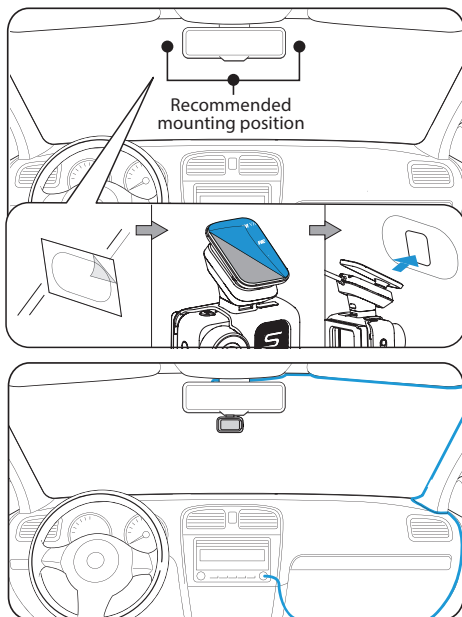


- 3 Mount the camera onto the windshield. You can power on the camera and view the live screen to find the optimal mounting position.

- Apply the adhesive film onto the cleaned windshield.
- Peel off the 3M VHB™ tape backer from the windshield mount and affix the camera to the center of the adhesive film.

NOTE: Avoid installing the product in a position that may obstruct the driver's line of sight.

- 4 Route the power cable through the headliner and pillars inside your vehicle. Connect the power adapter to your vehicle's 12/24V DC outlet. To ensure it doesn't obstruct the driver while driving, we recommend running it through the passenger side.



8. CONFIGURING THE MENU SETTINGS

Initial Setup

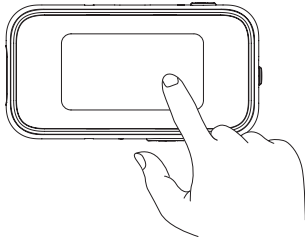
Set the date & time before using the camera (refer to page 18). The date stamps that appear on all future recordings will follow this setting. You may also sync the date & time to your phone by connecting the camera to the TYPE S Drive App.



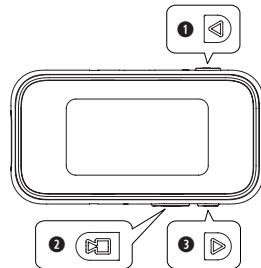
Body Camera Mode

Body Camera Mode lets you record on-the-go without needing to connect the camera to a power source. In this mode, the camera runs on its internal battery. Please ensure the camera is fully charged.

Apply configuration and settings to the camera using the touch screen or function buttons. Refer to the section below for the functions of each gesture or button under Body Camera Mode.

1. Video Mode

- Recording must be started manually. To do so, click ② .
- By default, 4K videos are recorded in 5-minute segments, while 2K and FHD videos are recorded in 15-minute segments. A countdown timer shows the remaining recording time for each segment. When the timer ends, recording stops automatically. To continue recording, press ②  again. All videos are saved onto the MicroSD card.
- Loop recording is not supported in Body Camera Mode. To ensure sufficient storage space for continued recording, regularly transfer your files to another storage device.
- Click ③  to toggle the monitor on/off.
- Press and hold ③  or swipe ← to switch to camera mode.

2. Camera Mode

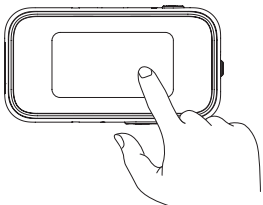
- Click ②  to capture a single photo or a burst. Check the camera settings (refer to page 17) to ensure the desired outcome.
- To zoom in, tap and hold  on the screen, then drag the zoom slider to 2 x or 4 x.
- Press and hold ③  or swipe ← to switch back to video mode.



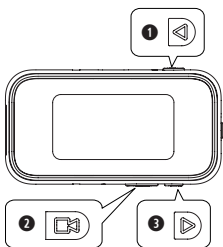
Dash Camera Mode

Dash Camera Mode is designed for use with the provided power adapter. If the adapter is not connected or an alternative one is used, the camera will automatically switch to Body Camera Mode, regardless of the mode selected on the switch.

1. Video Mode

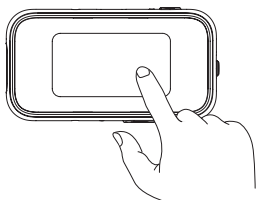
- The camera will begin recording automatically once it is powered on. You may also click 2 to start/stop recording manually.
- By default, videos are recorded in 1-minute segments and saved onto the MicroSD card. When the memory reaches capacity, new videos will overwrite the old ones.
- Click 3 to start an emergency video recording. The footage will be stored in the “Event” folder. Alternatively, use the voice command “Save video” (refer to page 9).
- Press and hold 3 or swipe ← to switch to camera mode.

2. Camera Mode

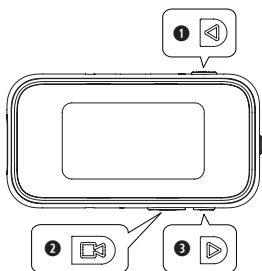
- Click 2 to capture a single photo or a burst. Check the camera settings (refer to page 17) to ensure the desired outcome.
- To zoom in, tap and hold on the screen, then drag the zoom slider to 2 x or 4 x.
- Press and hold 3 or swipe ← to switch back to video mode.

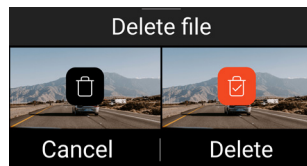
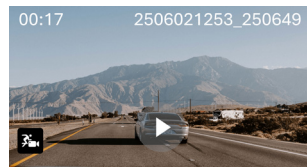
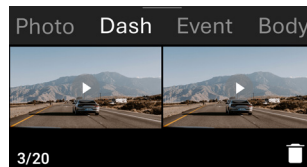
- From the live view, swipe ↑ to access the gallery.
- The gallery organizes your files by type: “Photo” for all captured photos; “Dash” for Dash Camera Mode recordings; “Event” for videos triggered manually, by G-Sensor, or by voice control; and “Body” for Body Camera Mode recordings.
- Tap the title bar or click 3 to access the folder of your selection.

Play Back and Manage Files

- Tap a file to view it full screen.
- Swipe ← / → or use 1 and 3 to navigate between files.
- Tap to play back the current file.
- In video playback, tap or click 3 to fast forward, and tap or click 1 to rewind the video at x 2, x 4 or x 8 speed.
- Swipe ↓ to return to the previews for next video.

Erase Files

- In previews, tap , then select the files you want to erase.
- Tap **Delete** to confirm.
- Swipe ↓ to exit the gallery.

To adjust settings on your camera:

- 1) From the live view, click  or swipe  to open the menu.
- 2) Tap the settings bar or use  and  to navigate to Video, Camera, or System settings.
- 3) Swipe  /  or click  to browse settings.

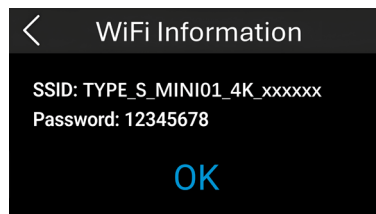
12. SETTING UP THE APP

Auto-sync with the Camera

1. Open the camera's menu and navigate to **System** Setting.
2. Go to **WiFi Information** and turn it on.

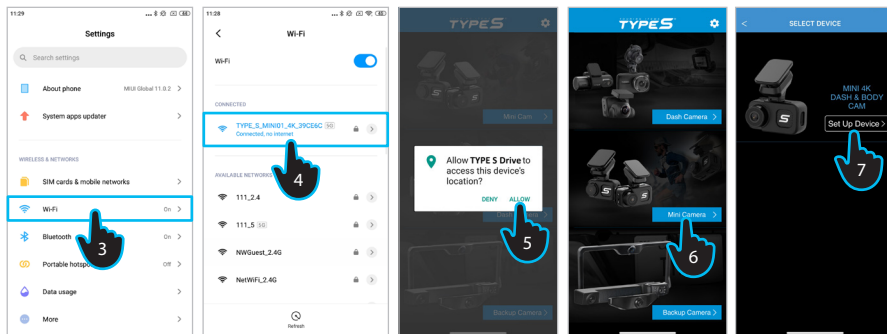
Before Connecting:

- If your vehicle has wireless **Apple CarPlay** or **wireless Android Auto** (the wired version is fine), please temporarily disconnect your phone from them, as they may hinder the connection.
- App connection is **NOT** mandatory for using the camera; it is primarily for accessing video files wirelessly. There's no need to maintain a constant connection.



Android Device

3. Navigate to the WiFi setting page on your device.
4. Connect to "TYPE_S_MINI01_4K_XXXXXX" with the default password "12345678".
5. Run the TYPE S Drive App. Click **Allow** in the pop-up message when prompted to allow the App to access your location.
6. Select the **Mini Camera** category.
7. Select **MINI 4K DASH & BODY CAM** and click **Set Up Device**.
8. Once connected, you will have the ability to view the live feed from the camera through the App. (Close proximity only, not for remote access).



NOTE:

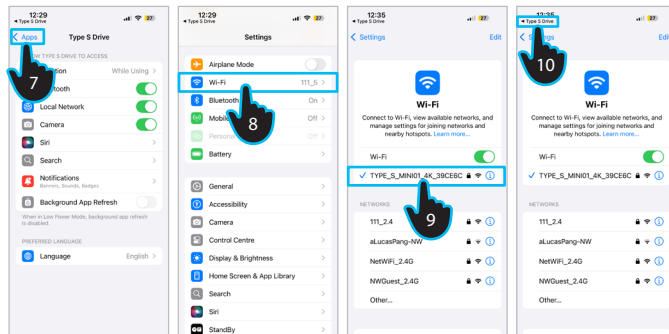
After the initial connection, the App retains your camera's network information. This ensures that you will be automatically directed to the live view the next time you connect, eliminating the need for manual reconnection.

The camera connects to only one device at a time. If it was previously connected to another device, make sure that device is either out of range or has WiFi turned off.



iOS Device (Follow Steps 1-2 from previous instructions)

- Please make sure Bluetooth, Location Services and Local Network Access are enabled on your device.
- Run the TYPE S Drive App and select the **Mini Camera** category.
- Select **MINI 4K DASH & BODY CAM** and click **Set Up Device**.
- Click  to go to App permissions setting page.
- Navigate to the main settings menu.
- Scroll to the top and click to enter the WiFi setting page.
- Connect to "TYPE_S_MINI01_4K_xxxxxx" with the default password "12345678".
- Click **TYPE S Drive** to return to the App.
- Once connected, you will have the ability to view the live feed from the camera through the App. (Close proximity only, not for remote access).



NOTE:

For older iPhones, you may need to temporarily switch off DATA to access this feature.

The camera connects to only one device at a time. If it was previously connected to another device, make sure that device is either out of range or has WiFi turned off.

After the initial connection, the App retains your camera's network information. Simply click **Join** to reconnect.

**WiFi Connection Troubleshooting**

If you're having trouble connecting, please follow these steps:

- 1) Disconnect wireless Apple CarPlay / Android Auto (not needed for wired).
- 2) Temporarily enable Airplane Mode. In WiFi setting, connect to the camera's WiFi network using password "12345678".
- 3) Return to the App and allow all permissions when prompted.
- 4) The "WiFi" feature is only for connecting the camera to your phone for wireless video access—it does not connect to home or public WiFi networks.

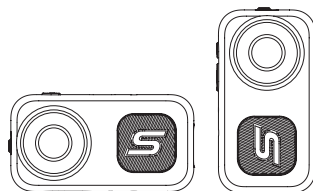
13. USING THE APP

Main Interface



Auto-Rotate Display

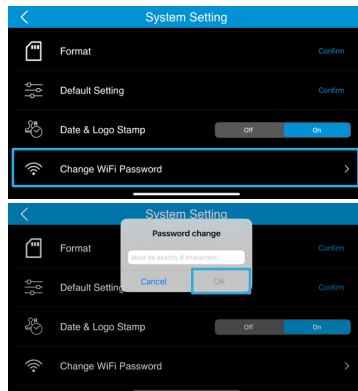
The App's auto-rotate feature tracks you in both portrait and landscape. Simply set up your shot, and the display will adjust to your camera's orientation for optimal viewing.



Change WiFi Password

Click  to open Main Menu, then navigate to System Setting > Change WiFi Password. Enter your preferred password (must be exactly 8 numeric characters), then click **OK**. Connect to your camera's WiFi network again with the revised password.

NOTE: It is recommended to reset your WiFi password upon initial connection to protect your data from unauthorized access.

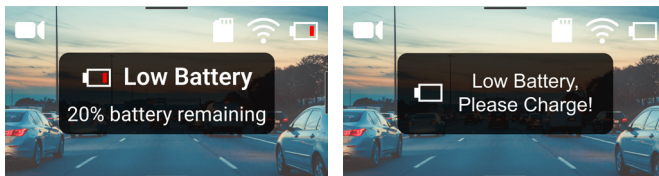


14. BATTERY LEVEL INDICATIONS

Please refer to the diagram below for battery level indications.



The display will also provide low-battery alerts. Please charge the camera promptly to prevent any interruptions.



NOTE: The built-in battery supports mobile recording in Body Camera Mode. However, when using Dash Camera Mode while driving, maintain the camera's connection to your vehicle's power source. This ensures it shuts down properly when the vehicle is turned off, avoiding excessive use of the battery.

15. CHARGING THE CAMERA

USB-A to USB-C Charging Cable (not included)



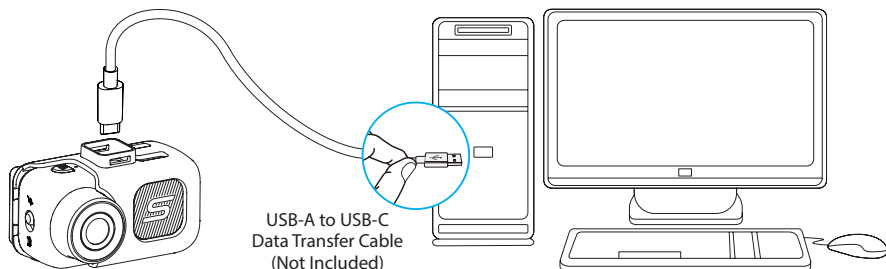
1. Plug the USB-A end of the charging cable into a USB-A port on a computer or wall adapter (not included).
2. Connect the USB-C end of the charging cable to the USB-C input port on the camera.
3. Disconnect the camera when it is fully charged.

NOTES:

Fully charge the camera before initial use. To preserve the battery life and performance, check the battery status regularly, charge when needed.

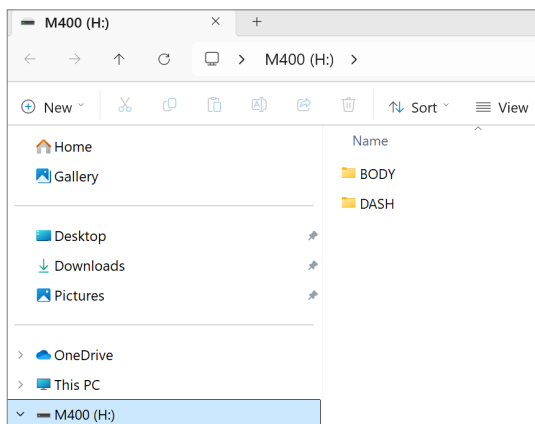
In order to reduce the risk of fire or electric shock, an adapter shall be chosen that is suitable for the application and is certified as a Class 2 or LPS power supply or power adapter.

16. VIEWING AND MANAGING MEDIA FILES USING A COMPUTER



Turn off the camera, then connect it to your computer via a USB-A to USB-C data transfer cable (not included). The camera will automatically switch to mass storage mode. In this mode, it will function as a card reader for the computer and be recognized as a new USB drive.

NOTE: The camera will not record when connected to a computer.



17. FAQs

1) Problem: Camera overheating.

Solution: Please try turning off the WiFi on the camera.

2) Problem: Voice control is unresponsive.

Solution: Please minimize background noise that might interfere with voice recognition. After saying the wake word "OK, MINI", listen for a beep to confirm the camera is ready for your command.

3) Problem: Dash Camera Mode is not working properly.

Solution: Please make sure that you're using the power adapter provided in this package. An alternative power adapter may interfere with the proper functionality of this feature.

4) Problem: Can't connect to home WiFi network.

Solution: The "WiFi" feature is only for connecting the camera to your phone for wireless video access. It does not connect to home or public WiFi and works only within about 30 feet

5) Problem: Can't connect to the App or access the live view.

Solution: Please try temporarily disconnecting from your Apple CarPlay, Android Auto, or mobile data. Turn on Airplane Mode and try again.

6) Problem: Video looks blurry in App.

Solution: The video is compressed in the App. It'll display at a higher quality once you've downloaded it to your phone or laptop.

7) Question: How does the camera handle continuous recording?

Answer: In Body Camera Mode, videos are recorded in segments: 4K for 5 minutes, 2K and FHD for 15 minutes. In Dash Camera Mode, shorter segments of 1, 3, or 5 minutes are used for easier content retrieval.

18. SAFETY INFORMATION

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

1. SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS – This manual contains important safety and operating instructions of the 12/24V cigarette lighter adapter for Model BT534745.
2. Before using the product, read all instructions and cautionary markings.
3. Do not expose cigarette lighter adapter to rain, moisture, or snow.
4. Use of an attachment not recommended or sold by the product manufacturer may result in a risk of fire, electric shock, or injury to persons.
5. To reduce risk of damage to cigarette lighter connector and cord, pull by cigarette lighter connector rather than cord when disconnecting cigarette lighter adapter.
6. Make sure cord is carefully secured so that it will not be stepped on, tripped over, or otherwise subjected to damage or stress.
7. Do not operate cigarette lighter adapter with damaged cord or cigarette lighter connector – replace it immediately.
8. Do not operate cigarette lighter adapter if it has received a sharp blow, been dropped, or otherwise damaged in any way; take it to a qualified serviceperson.
9. Do not disassemble cigarette lighter adapter; take it to a qualified serviceperson when service or repair is required. Incorrect reassembly may result in a risk of electric shock or fire.
10. To reduce risk of electric shock, unplug cigarette lighter adapter before attempting any maintenance or cleaning. Turning off controls will not reduce this risk.

WARNING: A failure to read and follow these warnings and instructions may result in a serious accident, including damaged property or a serious injury, including loss of life.

- Never depend on the dash cam and body cam entirely when engaging in activities such as driving or outdoor pursuits. The image on the screen is different from actual conditions. Objects viewed in the dash cam and body cam display screen differ from actual distance because a wide-angle lens is used.
- Always check the surroundings carefully. For outdoor pursuits, maintain awareness of your environment and be alert of potential hazards. For vehicle use, inspect all areas around the vehicle visually using mirrors before proceeding.
- The dash cam and body cam is designed as an aid to the driver in detecting large stationary objects to help avoid damaging the vehicle. However, you, the driver, must use it safely and properly. Use of the dash cam and body cam is not a substitute for safe, proper and legal driving.

- The area displayed by the dash cam and body cam is limited. The dash cam and body cam does not display objects that are out of the camera's field of view. The area displayed on the screen may vary according to vehicle orientation or road conditions.
- Be sure to check the camera's position and mounting angle before each use.
- Do not strike the dash cam and body cam. It is a precision instrument. Otherwise, it may malfunction or cause damage resulting in a fire or an electric shock.
- This product will only provide images of items that are within the field of view of the dash cam and body cam. Thus, it is imperative that the dash cam and body cam should be kept clean and unobstructed.
- Adhere to all applicable traffic laws and motor vehicle regulations applicable to the device.
- Consult local laws and regulations for any restrictions on installation or use.
- Never allow children to play with the device. Small parts may be a choking hazard.
- There is a plastic cover over the dash cam and body cam. Do not scratch the cover when cleaning dirt or snow from it.
- If the temperature changes rapidly, the system may not operate normally.
- When strong light directly enters a camera, objects may not be displayed clearly.
- The screen may flicker under fluorescent light.
- The colors of objects on the dash cam and body cam may differ from those of the actual objects.
- Do not use alcohol or thinner to clean the camera. This will cause discoloration. To clean the camera, wipe with a clean cloth dampened with mild cleaner diluted with water and then wipe with a dry cloth.

SAFETY AROUND AND BEHIND OTHER VEHICLES

Using a dash cam and body cam is not enough to completely overcome a vehicle's blind spot. Many preventable injuries and deaths occur in driveways or parking lots when drivers do not see children, pets, or others near their vehicles. Here are a few safety tips that will help you to avoid an accident:

- Walk completely around your vehicle before getting in. Check for kids, toys, and pets before entering the vehicle and starting the engine.
- Know where children are. Have children stand in a place where they are in full view.
- Be aware of young children. Young children are small and hard to see.
- Parents, caregivers and all adults need to be vigilant in supervising children, especially when children are in the yard, driveway or parking lot playing near parked cars.

- Roll down your window so you will be able to hear what is happening outside your vehicle.
- Owners of SUVs, trucks, and vans need to take extra care to avoid hitting or running over a child.
- Teach children to move away from a vehicle whenever it is started.

19. MAINTENANCE & WARRANTY

CLEANING

- If dirt, rain or snow attaches to the camera, the display screen may not clearly display objects. If water droplets, snow or mud adhere to the camera lens, rinse with water and wipe with a dry cloth.
- Do not use alcohol, benzene or thinner to clean the camera. This will cause discoloration. To clean the camera, wipe with a clean cloth dampened with mild cleaner diluted with water and then wipe with a dry cloth.

WARRANTY
