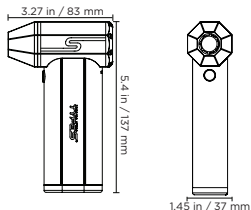

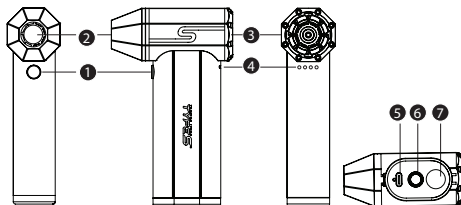

- k) When charging the internal battery, work in a well-ventilated area and do not restrict ventilation in any way.

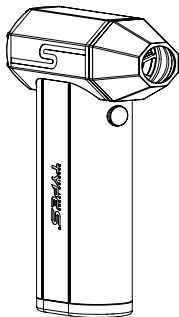
## CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

- Unplug the Air Duster before cleaning it with a damp cloth. Use only mild cleaning agents, no solvents or corrosive chemicals.

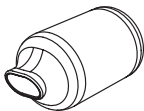

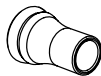

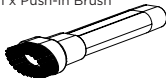

## CHARGING THE AIR DUSTER

### USB-C Charging Cable



1. Plug the one end of the charging cable into a USB-C port on a 5V 2A / 9V 2A USB wall adapter (not included).
2. Connect the other end of the charging cable to the USB-C input port on the air duster.
3. Disconnect the air duster when it is fully charged. Store the air duster in a safe place when not in use.
4. If charging via a USB-C source, such as a laptop or power bank, double - press the air duster's bottom switch.

We recommend using the USB-C cable provided in this package as your charging cable.

## LED Indicators

While charging, the LED Indicators will flash in succession to indicate the current charge level. All lights will stay on solid when the air duster is fully charged.

## CAUTION

DO NOT use the device while it is charging. Always disconnect the device from the power source before operating.

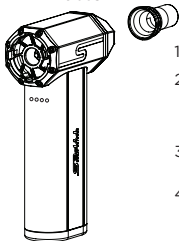
## NOTE

Fully charge the air duster before initial use. To preserve the battery life and performance, check the battery status regularly, charge when needed. Recharge every 2-3 months if air duster is not being used.

In order to reduce the risk of fire or electric shock, an adapter shall be chosen that is suitable for the application and is certified as a Class 2 or LPS power supply or power adapter.

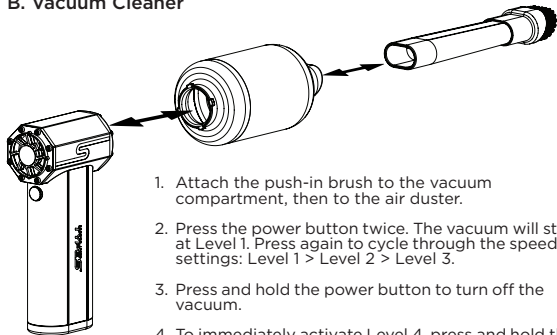
# OPERATION

## A. Air Duster



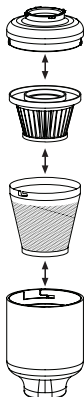
1. Attach the blow nozzle to the air duster.
2. Press the power button twice. The air duster will start at Level 1. Press again to cycle through the speed settings: Level 1 > Level 2 > Level 3.
3. Press and hold the power button to turn off the air duster.
4. To immediately activate Level 4, press and hold the power button while the air duster is off. Release to stop the airflow.

## B. Vacuum Cleaner



1. Attach the push-in brush to the vacuum compartment, then to the air duster.
2. Press the power button twice. The vacuum will start at Level 1. Press again to cycle through the speed settings: Level 1 > Level 2 > Level 3.
3. Press and hold the power button to turn off the vacuum.
4. To immediately activate Level 4, press and hold the power button while the vacuum is off. Release to stop the suction.

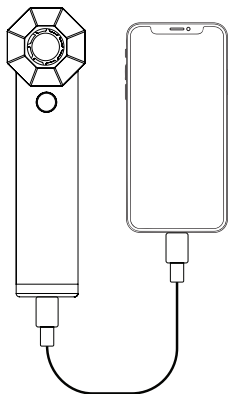
## Cleaning and Maintenance



1. Detach the vacuum compartment from the unit.
2. Hold the compartment upright and twist the cap counterclockwise to open.
3. Take out the filter and the mesh, then empty the contents of the vacuum compartment.
4. Reassemble the vacuum compartment.

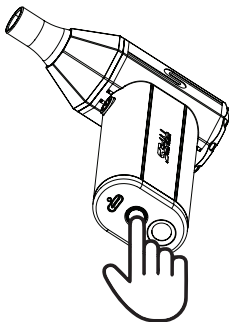


### C. Power Bank



Charge your mobile device using either the original charging cable or an approved cable certified by the manufacturer.

### D. Flash Light
