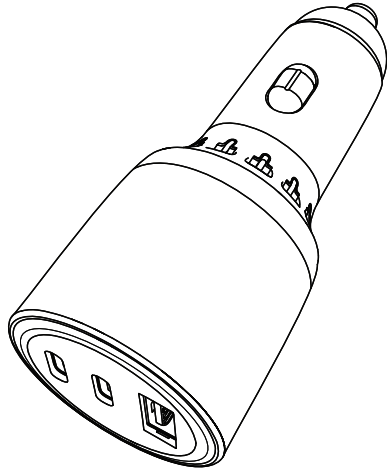

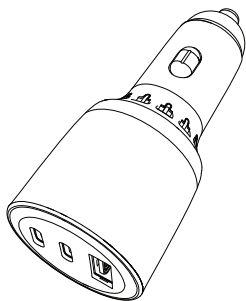

2. Before using the car charger, read all instructions and cautionary markings.
3. Do not expose car charger to rain, moisture, or snow.

5. To reduce risk of damage to car charger and cord, pull by cigarette lighter connector rather than cord when disconnecting car charger.

7. Do not operate car charger with damaged cord or cigarette lighter connector – replace it immediately.
8. Do not operate car charger if it has received a sharp blow, been dropped, or otherwise damaged in any way; take it to a qualified serviceperson.
9. Do not disassemble car charger; take it to a qualified serviceperson when service or repair is required. Incorrect reassembly may result in a risk of electric shock or fire.
10. To reduce risk of electric shock, unplug car charger before attempting any maintenance or cleaning. Turning off controls will not reduce this risk.
11. The car charger can get very hot after full power operation. Avoid prolonged skin contact and allow the device to completely cool before disconnecting the charger.
12. When temperature is high, car charger will reduce output power to prevent overheating. Power will go up again when temperature cools down.
13. When the vehicle battery voltage is under 10.5V, car charger will turn off automatically until the battery voltage returns to 10.5V.
14. When the vehicle battery voltage is between 10.5V and 11.4V, car charger can only output at 5V.

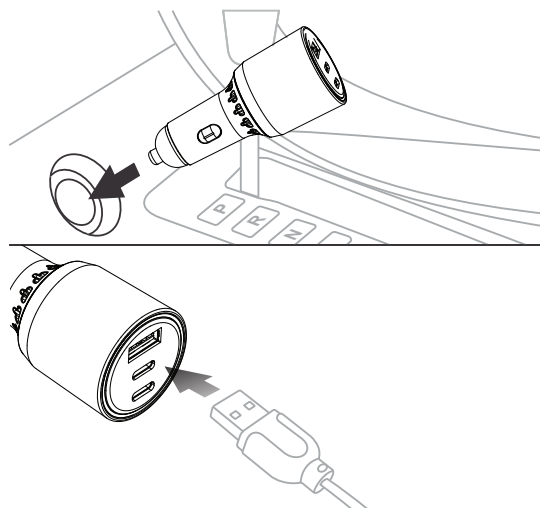

CHARGING YOUR DEVICE

Utilize this car charger to charge smartphones, tablets, and any other compatible devices.

1. Connect your charging cable (not included) to the car charger, then insert the charger into your vehicle's 12V or 24V power socket.
2. Connect the other end of the cable to your device.

NOTE: Make sure the car charger is securely plugged into your vehicle's socket. A loose connection may prevent your device from charging properly.
