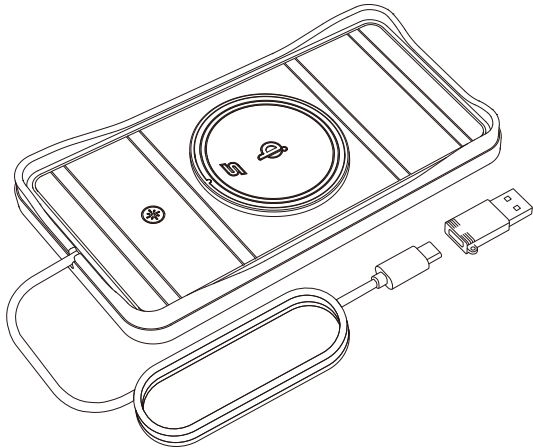

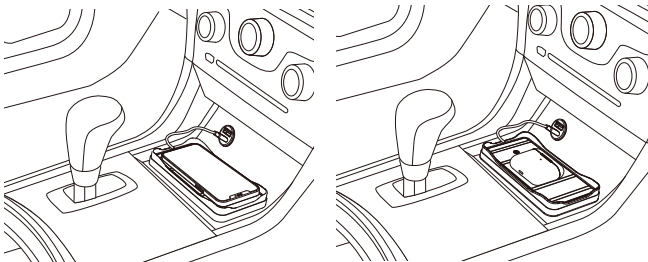

Care & Use Instructions



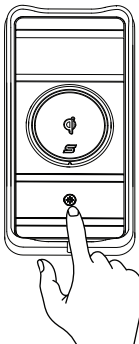
Important, retain for future reference:
Read carefully

2. Set the charging pad on a flat, stable surface. Center your Qi-compatible device on it.
- Remove any cases, metal objects, or accessories that may interfere with wireless charging.
 - If charging doesn't start right away, adjust the position of your device.
 - Make sure the pad and device are placed where they won't get bumped or knocked over easily.



RGB LIGHTS

To enhance your charging experience, tap  to turn the RGB lights on. Tap again to turn them off. The charging pad will continue to charge your device even when the lights are off.

FAQS

- 1) Question: Why isn't my phone charging?
Answer: Try the following:
 - Remove the phone case (especially thick or magnetic ones).
 - Align the phone properly on the center of the pad.
 - Check the power source—some USB ports don't provide enough output.
- 2) Question: Why are the RGB lights flashing?
Answer: Flashing lights indicate a charging issue:
 - The pad detects a device but isn't charging. Make sure the device is properly aligned and Qi-compatible.
 - The pad is overheating. Disconnect it and let it cool in a well-ventilated area. Avoid using power-intensive apps while charging.
- 3) Question: What's the maximum charging speed?
Answer: The pad supports up to 15W wireless charging, but actual speed depends on:
 - Your device's charging limit
 - The output power of your USB port or car charger
 - Battery level (charging slows down as the battery fills)
- 4) Question: Will it damage my dashboard in hot weather?
Answer: No. It features a high-temp-resistant silicone base that won't melt or stick—unlike competitors that use PVC, which can warp or damage surfaces in heat.
- 5) Question: Can I use it with a phone case on?
Answer: Sometimes. Remove thick or metal-backed cases and make sure your device is properly centered on the pad. Poor alignment is a common cause of slow or failed charging.

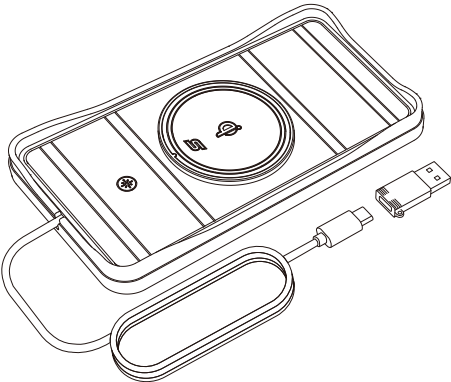

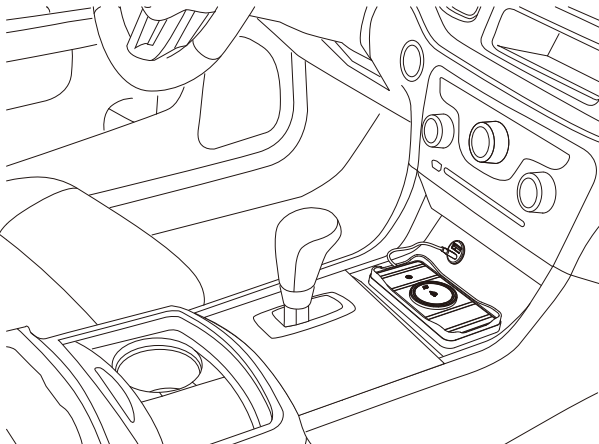

CHARGING YOUR DEVICE

1. Connect the charging pad.
 - If you're using a USB-A port, attach the adapter first.
 - Plug a USB-C or USB-A car charger (not included) into your vehicle's 12V outlet, then connect the charging pad.
 - Alternatively, connect the pad to a wall power adapter* (not included).
 - Make sure your charger or adapter provides at least 18W of power.

* **NOTE:** To reduce the risk of fire or electric shock, use a power adapter that is appropriate for the application and certified as a Class 2 or LPS power supply.
